27 **STRATEGIC NOTICE OF PUBLIC DISSEMINATION OF COURT FILINGS AND PROCEEDINGS**

28 To the Honorable Judge Lisa Wahlin and the Clerk of the Court:

Petitioner, Maureen G. Mulvaney, appearing **pro per**, respectfully submits this Strategic Notice to inform the Court of ongoing public dissemination of court filings, judicial proceedings, and court-ordered disclosures by **Respondent, David Charles Olesen**.

This Notice is submitted for record preservation, judicial awareness, and protection of personal sensitive information associated with this matter.

I. Public Dissemination of Court Filings

Respondent, David Charles Olesen, has published copies of court pleadings, minute entries, financial disclosures documents, corporate documents, and materials produced pursuant to Court order and redistributed on publicly accessible websites, including but not limited to:

These sites operated by Respondent prominently identify:

- This Court
- The name of the Presiding Judicial Officer, Hon. Lisa Wahlin
- The judicial officers
- Judicial minute entries
- Official court materials, pleadings and documents associated with this proceeding
- Court-Ordered financial disclosures
- Personal Identifying information produced in compliance with Court Orders
- Corporate and banking documentation produced pursuant to court directive
- Visual recordings of actual Court proceedings and court personnel
- Over twenty edited video segments of recorded hearings
- The Official Medical Examiner's Report of the deceased wage earner, Mayre Gie Olesen

These materials were obtained through the judicial process and are being distributed publicly outside the Court System.

II. Public Dissemination of Court Proceedings

Additionally, Respondent has published and disseminated over twenty (20) edited video recordings of actual court proceedings depicting portions of those court hearings — including appearances by the Judge, court personnel, counsel, and Petitioner — via a publicly accessible YouTube channel associated with Respondent:

1 The recordings have been edited and redistributed in a manner that extends beyond the original
2 courtroom setting.

3 **III. Identity Theft Implications**

4 The public dissemination of court-ordered financial disclosures and identifying information has
5 coincided with confirmed identity theft affecting an immediate family member.

6 A formal Identity Theft Report has been filed with the Federal Trade Commission:

7 **FTC Identity Theft Report No. 197364711**

8 A cybercrime complaint has also been submitted to federal authorities.

10 The **Official Medical Examiner’s Report** of a deceased individual has likewise been
11 republished online, along with extensive personal identifying information concerning family
12 members. The public aggregation of this information increases vulnerability to financial
13 exploitation and misuse.

14 While causation remains under investigation, the temporal connection between online exposure
15 of sensitive materials and confirmed fraud has heightened concerns regarding misuse of court-
16 produced information.

17 **IV. Judicial Integrity and Rule 122 Considerations**

18 Arizona Supreme Court Rule 122 governs public access to judicial records and reflects the
19 Court’s authority to protect privacy, safety, and the integrity of judicial proceedings. While
20 certain records may be publicly accessible, **Rule 122 does not contemplate or authorize mass
21 republication, external redistribution, or repurposing of court filings in a manner that
22 facilitates harassment, intimidation, or identity-related financial harm.**

23 The materials at issue were obtained through the judicial process and produced pursuant to Court
24 order for use within this proceeding. They are now being redistributed outside the Court system
25 through external platforms controlled by Respondent.

26 The scope and volume of redistributed materials— including over 140 documents of personal
27 financial disclosures and sensitive identifying information — materially increase the risk of
28 misuse beyond the judicial purpose for which the documents were produced.

This Notice does not seek retroactive sealing of the record. Rather, it respectfully alerts the Court
that materials generated through judicial process are being republished externally in a manner
that has:

- Increased risk of identity-related harm and identity-theft
- Undermined the integrity of court-ordered disclosures
- Exposed sensitive personal and financial information beyond the courtroom context

V. Purpose of This Filing

Petitioner respectfully submits this Notice solely to:

1. Preserve a formal record of the public dissemination
2. Alert the Court to potential misuse of judicial filings
3. Ensure judicial awareness should protective measures later become necessary

Petitioner respectfully requests that this Notice be entered into the record.
