yesdude.com website shutdown.

I could not determine the hack that basically disabled my website, but it was disabled to the point that it would no longer serve web pages. It required a full rebuild.

So, this time I totally banned the offending IP. I also hardened the server to prevent flooding and probing. I've been running yesdude.com for decades, yet now I'm the target of a hacker? There is nothing to steal and it wasn't used to flood out spam emails or host nefarious material. I could even use remote desktop to get in still. Just the ability to host web pages was disabled.

What eventually prevented web page access I do not know. spent hours trying to figure it out. Eventually had to nuke the Virtual Machine and Start over. I suspect that killed more evidence, but I have the web log files and some other event logs.

GoDaddy is the host. They may have more IP logs.

Are there any other witnesses or persons affected by this incident?

This is a development server and someplace I keep other information I find useful to get to from the internet. yesdude.com does not get a lot of traffic. It was easy to filter out the IP addresses that were accessing the website. Even to the point of finding Maureen's alleged IP address (70.162.213.200). She simply wants the information removed and perhaps decided to employ someone to do it. I have been in court proceedings for the better part of a decade. Illegal activity is still illegal activity.
