**P E T I T I O N**

COMES NOW, the petitioners by the undersigned attorney, and unto this Honorable Court, most respectfully avers that:

1. That petitioner David Charles Olesen is of legal age, American, married, and residing at Sitio Punod, Brgy. Tinago, San Isidro, Leyte, Philippines, where he can be served with notices, orders and other legal processes of the Honorable Court, while Petitioner Ilyn O. Olesen is of legal age, Filipino, married, and residing at Sitio Punod, Brgy. Tinago, San Isidro, Leyte, Philippines, where he can be served with notices, orders and other legal processes of the Honorable Court;

2. That respondent is of legal age, American, Divorcee, and a resident of 16026, 36<sup>th</sup> St., Phoenix, AZ 85048-7322, U.S.A.. She maybe served with summons, notices, orders and other legal processes of the Honorable Court through her email address at MGM@MGM SuperStar.com;

**ALLEGATIONS COMMON TO ALL  
CAUSES OF ACTION**

3. That respondent is the former mother-in-law of petitioner David Charles Olesen as the former is the mother of latter's former deceased wife Mayre Gie Olesen, who died on September 16, 2019 at Tempe, Maricopa County, Arizona, USA;

4. That petitioner David Charles Olesen and his former deceased wife Mayre Gie Olesen have two (2) children, namely: 1.) Mikayla Genevieve Olesen and 2.) Matthew Liam Olesen, who were born on March 14, 2013 and May 31, 2015, *respectively*, both in Banner Desert Medical Center in Mesa, Maricopa County, Arizona, USA;

5. That on June 08, 2019, petitioner David Charles Olesen married again to petitioner Ilyn O. Olesen;

6. That petitioners on September 09, 2021 obtain an Order of Adoption from the Court of Arizona, County of Maricopa, Juvenile Division, wherein Ilyn O. Olesen's request to adopt Mikayla Genevieve Olesen and Matthew Liam Olesen was granted and that the adoptive parent and the said minor children shall and do bear toward each other the relationship of parent and child, copy of the Order of Adoption is hereto attached as **Annex "A"** and series, and made an integral part of this petition;

7. That respondent is the grandmother of the minor children Mikayla Genevieve Olesen and Matthew Liam Olesen, grandmother and minor children are all American nationals, but the latter are now residing in the Philippines together with their biological father and adoptive mother;

8. That the minor children Mikayla Genevieve Olesen and Matthew Liam Olesen needs support which comprises everything indispensable for sustenance, dwelling, clothing, medical attendance, education and transportation, in keeping with the financial capacity of the family;

9. That the minor children are now in the Philippines together with the petitioners and they are studying in a private school in Ormoc City;

10. That petitioners as of this time are shouldering the support of the minor children which comprise everything indispensable for sustenance;

11. That petitioners since they relocate to the Philippines have no means of income, because they are unemployed, they sustain only in supporting the minor children through their savings which are now depleted and could no longer cope up the support indispensable

for sustenance of the minor children Mikayla Genevieve Olesen and Matthew Liam Olesen;

### **FIRST CAUSE OF ACTION The Plea for the Support**

12. That petitioners are demanding from respondent children support, as the latter is also obliged to give support to her grandchildren being the ascendant nearest in degree and she has the resources to extend the same;

13. That the respondent has the means and resources to extend support to the minor children Mikayla Genevieve Olesen and Matthew Liam Olesen, who are her grandchildren, because she is a Rated School Nutrition Speaker in their country who earns thousands of dollars in every Speaking Engagement Contract Agreement, as evidenced by her sample Speaking Engagement Contract Agreement Form hereto attached as **Annex "B" and Series**;

14. That considering the present cost of living, the minor children Mikayla Genevieve Olesen and Matthew Liam Olesen need a monthly allowance of at least, One Hundred Thousand Pesos (P100,000.00) each child or a total of Two Hundred Thousand Pesos (P200,000.00) per month for the two (2) minor children;

15. That the name of witnesses to be presented are as follows; 1.) Petitioner David Charles Olesen with residence at Sitio Punod, Brgy. Tinago, San Isidro, Leyte; 2.) Petitioner Ilyn O. Olesen with residence at Sitio Punod, Brgy. Tinago, San Isidro, Leyte; and 3.) A reserved witness to be named later who is an employee of the school where the minor children are enrolled which will be named later. The summary of the testimony of David Charles Olesen is that he will prove the material allegations in the petition. Ilyn O. Olesen will testify to prove the material allegations in the petition. The summary of the testimony of the reserved witness is that he/she will testify as to the cost of the tuition of the school of the minor children;

16. That the documentary evidences are attached to the petition and are respectively marked, the following:

- a.) Order of Adoption – Exhibit "A" and Series
- b.) Speaking Engagement Contract Agreement Form – Exhibit "B" and Series

### P R A Y E R

WHEREFORE, it is respectfully prays for judgment:

1. Ordering the respondent to give the minor children Mikayla Genevieve Olesen and Matthew Liam Olesen a monthly allowance of One Hundred Thousand Pesos (P100,000.00) each of them, to be paid on or before the 28<sup>th</sup> day of every month, as support for their sustenance;

2. After trial, ordering that said monthly support be made permanent until the minor children finished their studies or until they reached the age of majority whichever comes first;

3. Ordering that the monthly support maybe increased proportionately, according to the necessities of the minor children;

4. Ordering respondent to reimburse petitioners for attorney's fees in the amount of Fifty Thousand Pesos (P50,000.00) representing acceptance fee, and Four Thousand Pesos (P4,000.00) representing appearance fee whenever the case is called for hearing;

5. Such other relief's and remedies equitable in the premises are also prayed for.
