19 Procedure, consistent with the Seal of the State of Arizona, the signature of  
20 the Maricopa County Clerk, and an attestation by the Clerk that "The


1 foregoing instrument is a full, true and correct copy of the original on file with  
2 this office.” (See relevant language from Rule 44, Federal Rules of Civil  
3 Procedure attached in Exhibit A.) However, Boyd County finds Maricopa’s  
4 certification deficient and will not provide full faith and credit to the Orders  
5 as issued and certified without the completion of the attached “Certification  
6 Act of Congress.”

Such Acts, records and judicial proceedings or copies thereof, so authenticated, shall have the same full faith and credit in every court within the United States and its Territories and Possessions as they have by law or usage in the courts of such State, Territory or Possession from which they are taken.
